Cloverbud Presentation

Counties and districts may offer a category for Cloverbuds.

This category is noncompetitive and provides equal recognition for all participants. This optional category provides young participants an opportunity to make presentations without the task of finding or writing material and without the stress of competition.

Recitation of the 4-H Pledge, Pledge of Allegiance or other simple verse is appropriate. However, Cloverbud participants wishing to write or develop another presentation may do so.

Cloverbud Presentation is a participation (noncompetitive) event and may be available at a local or county event.
