

HOUSING and DINING OPTIONS FOR TRANSFER STUDENTS

Housing Options

Transfer students at North Dakota State University have a variety of housing options available to them including on-campus residence halls and student apartments as well as off-campus options. Students beginning at NDSU **within one calendar year** from the date of high school graduation are **required** to live on campus and are assigned to (and guaranteed) housing in one of NDSU’s first-year student residence halls.

Students transferring **more than one year** after graduating from high school may apply for one of NDSU’s upper-division residence

halls or student apartments below, or may also choose to live off campus.

Transfer students are encouraged to apply for residence halls using the online housing application as soon as they have been admitted to NDSU. On-Campus Apartments

Students who have reached 20 years of age by the time of occupancy or completed at least two semesters of college-level course work post-high school graduation are eligible to apply for one of NDSU's on-campus apartments. On-campus apartments are high in demand and interested students are encouraged to apply early.

A waiting list is established based on the date that the apartment application and application fee are received. Students may apply for

an on-campus apartment prior to being admitted to NDSU, but must meet eligibility requirements before moving in.
