A qualified and trained professional through Pediatric Partners will provide a free Ages & Stages developmental screening for your child that evaluates language, cognitive, gross motor, fine motor, and social-emotional development. Screenings will be conducted in the classroom annually (additional follow up screenings as needed) to measure your child's developmental skills. The screening results will be shared with parents and the Center through written consent and documentation.

Screening results will be used to:

- Plan developmentally appropriate curriculum and environments to promote learning
- Help teachers prepare for Parent-Teacher conferences
- Help to make referrals for further evaluation with parental permission
- Help write individual educational goals
