- The boundaries for zip code 58374 changed significantly between 1990 and 2000 (see boundary maps). Therefore, an assessment of change between 1990 and 2000 using these data is not appropriate.
- In 1990, zip code 58374 encompassed most of the top section of Eddy County and included 627 residents. In 2000, a boundary change enlarged the territory to include a small section of Wells and Benson counties, expanding the population base to 699 residents.
- Between 1990 and 2000, Eddy County experienced a modest decline in population. Population projections for Eddy County indicate that population declines are likely to continue over the next two decades.
- In 2000, 30 percent of residents in zip code 58374 and 26 percent in Eddy County were younger than 20 years of age. In addition, 24 percent of residents in zip code 58374 and 25 percent in Eddy County were 65 years and older. Between 1990 and 2000, Eddy County saw a decline in the proportion of youth and little change in the proportion of elderly. Population projections for Eddy County indicate that this loss of youth will likely to continue over the next two decades; however, the proportion of elderly is expected to increase.
- There was little change in the racial diversity of Eddy County between 1990 and 2000; nearly all residents were white. However, in zip code 58374, 19 percent of residents were American Indians and Alaska Natives in 2000.

- The boundaries for zip code 58374 changed significantly between 1990 and 2000 (see boundary maps). Therefore, an assessment of change between 1990 and 2000 using these data is not appropriate.
- Eddy County experienced a decline in total housing units between 1990 and 2000. In 2000, 62 percent of housing was owner-occupied in Eddy County compared to 52 percent in zip code 58374.
- Between 1990 and 2000, vacant housing units declined in Eddy County. In 2000, vacant housing comprised 18 percent of all housing in Eddy County and 33 percent in zip code 58374.
- In 2000, the median value of an owner-occupied home in zip code 58374 was \$25,300, compared to \$34,000 in Eddy County. The 2000 median value in Eddy County was actually lower than its corresponding 1990 value after adjusting for inflation.
- In 2000, half of all housing units in both zip code 58374 and in Eddy County were built before 1954.

- The boundaries for zip code 58374 changed significantly between 1990 and 2000 (see boundary maps). Therefore, an assessment of change between 1990 and 2000 using these data is not appropriate.
- The median household income in zip code 58374 was \$24,632 in 2000, compared to \$28,642 in Eddy County. When the 1990 median values are adjusted for inflation, the 2000 median household income represents an increase in purchasing power for Eddy County residents.
- Between 1990 and 2000, the proportion of impoverished residents remained relatively unchanged in Eddy County. In 2000, 10 percent of residents in Eddy County and 19 percent in zip code 58374 were impoverished.
- The number of impoverished children in Eddy County remained relatively unchanged between 1990 and 2000; however, the number of elderly living in poverty declined. In 2000, 29 percent of impoverished residents in Eddy County were children and 26 percent were elderly. In zip code 58374, 40 percent of persons living in poverty were children and 20 percent were elderly in 2000.
