- The boundaries for zip code 58625 changed significantly between 1990 and 2000 (see boundary maps). Therefore, an assessment of change between 1990 and 2000 using these data is not appropriate.
- In 1990, zip code 58625 encompassed a small territory in and around the city of Dodge with 164 residents. A boundary change in 2000 expanded the territory to the south and includes a sliver of west central Mercer County for a total of 259 people.
- Dunn County experienced a decline in population between 1990 and 2000. Population projections for Dunn County indicate that population declines are likely to continue over the next two decades.
- In 2000, 30 percent of residents in both zip code 58625 and Dunn County were under 20 years of age and 17 percent were ages 65 and older. Population projections for Dunn County indicate that the proportion of youth is likely to decline and the proportion of elderly will likely increase over the next two decades.
- Dunn County experienced a slight increase in the number of American Indians and Alaska Natives between 1990 and 2000. In 2000, American Indians and Alaska Natives comprised 12 percent of all residents in Dunn County and 3 percent in zip code 58625.

- The boundaries for zip code 58625 changed significantly between 1990 and 2000 (see boundary maps). Therefore, an assessment of change between 1990 and 2000 using these data is not appropriate.
- The number of housing units in Dunn County declined between 1990 and 2000. In 2000, 56 percent of housing in Dunn County and 66 percent of housing in zip code 58625 was owner-occupied.
- The vacant housing rate in Dunn County remained relatively unchanged between 1990 and 2000 at approximately 30 percent. In 2000, vacant housing comprised 28 percent of all housing in zip code 58625.
- In 2000, the median value of an owner-occupied home in zip code 58625 was \$22,500, compared to \$37,400 in Dunn County. The 2000 median value in Dunn County was actually lower than the 1990 value after adjusting for inflation.
- In 2000, half of all housing units in zip code 58625 were built before 1964; half of all housing units in Dunn County were built before 1966.

- The boundaries for zip code 58625 changed significantly between 1990 and 2000 (see boundary maps). Therefore, an assessment of change between 1990 and 2000 using these data is not appropriate.
- The median household income in zip code 58625 was \$24,643 in 2000, compared to \$30,015 in Dunn County. When the 1990 median values are adjusted for inflation, the 2000 median household income represents an increase in purchasing power for Dunn County residents.
- Dunn County experienced a decline in the number and proportion of people living below poverty between 1990 and 2000. Nonetheless, 18 percent of Dunn County residents and 14 percent of residents in zip code 58625 were impoverished in 2000.
- The number of both impoverished youth and impoverished elderly declined in Dunn County between 1990 and 2000. In 2000, 36 percent of impoverished residents in Dunn County were children and 13 percent were elderly. In contrast, 19 percent of impoverished residents in zip code 58625 were children and 46 percent were elderly in 2000.

- Dunn County reported 37 births in 2005, a rate of 10.28 per 1,000 persons. This rate was up from 6.94 in 2002.
- In 2005, 34 deaths were reported in Dunn County, down from 42 in 2002. Major contributors to death were heart disease and cancer.
- In 2005, there were six foster care placements in Dunn County, down from nine in 2002.

- Dunn County saw a decline in the labor force between 1990 and 2000. This could be attributed to the corresponding changes in overall persons 16 years and older during the same time period.
- In 2000, the unemployment rate was 6.4 percent in Dunn County and 8.2 percent in zip code 58625.

- The boundaries for zip code 58625 changed significantly between 1990 and 2000 (see boundary maps). Therefore, an assessment of change between 1990 and 2000 using these data is not appropriate.
- Dunn County saw a decline in total employment between 1990 and 2000.
- The percentage of employed that was female increased in Dunn County between 1990 and 2000. In 2000, females comprised 45 percent of all employed in zip code 58625 and 47 percent in Dunn County.
- Between 1990 and 2000, Dunn County saw declines in agricultural and retail trade employment and growth in manufacturing and service industry employment. In 2000, agriculture was the largest industry in zip code 58625, employing 41 percent of all workers. In Dunn County, agriculture comprised 26 percent of all workers in 2000, down from 47 percent in 1990.

- The K-12 enrollment for Dodge Public School District totaled 30 students in 2004-2005, down from 58 in 2001-2002.
- In 2004-2005, 71 percent of students in the Dodge Public School District were proficient or advanced in reading and 67 percent of students were proficient or advanced in math.
