STUDENT MEAL PLANS

UNLIMITED ACCESS MEAL PLANS

These plans allow you to pop into any of our three dining centers as many times as you want. Need a caffeine pick-me-up, a quick snack or a full meal? Feel free to come and go as you please.

- 👉 **Five-day Meal Plan – \$2,300/semester**
Unlimited access Monday – Friday | 3 guest passes/semester
- 👉 **Seven-day Meal Plan – \$2,582.50/semester**
Unlimited access Monday – Sunday | 7 guest passes/semester
- 👉 Unlimited meal plans include 3 takeout meals/day (one per meal period).

BLOCK MEAL PLANS

Block plans can be used at all three dining centers, all four coffee shops and the NDSU Food Court. Block plans are popular for upperclassmen and off-campus students who still want to take advantage of the variety and convenience provided by NDSU Dining. The more you buy, the more you save.

25 Block.....\$10/meal (\$250)
50 Block.....\$9.25/meal (\$462.50)
75 Block.....\$8.50/meal (\$637.50)

100 Block..... \$8/meal (\$800)
170 Block.....\$8/meal (\$1,360)

SELECTING A MEAL PLAN

First-year students:

Students in their first year are required to select one of the unlimited access meal plans. Need help deciding between the five- and seven-day plans? The five-day plan is only recommended for students who plan to leave campus every weekend. The seven-day plan is only \$16 more per weekend. Plus, it comes with an additional four guest passes.

Meal plan changes:

1. Download the GET Mobile app or visit nds.edu/dining/get
2. Login
 - A. If this is your first time, you will be asked to select NDSU and a PIN
 - B. Allow GET to send important notifications
3. Select “Change Meal Plan”
(if using the app, this option is located in “settings”)
4. Select your preferred plan
5. Click “Submit”



DINING CENTERS

WEST DINING CENTER

- Connected to Cater, Pavek, Seim, Sevrinson and Thompson Halls
- Features: Wood-stone pizza, smoothies, global cuisine, homestyle classics and an in-house bakery
- Allergen friendly: The WDC is NDSU's tree nut- and peanut-free facility. Clean Eats is a food station within the WDC that offers entrées, side dishes and desserts that are free from the top nine allergens, including gluten.

RESIDENCE DINING CENTER

- Connected to Reed/Johnson and Weible Halls
- Features: Full-service coffee shop, custom-ordered creations, homestyle classics and global cuisine.

- Features: Student DIY grill station, homestyle classics station and a salad/sandwich bar

DINING CENTER HOW-TO

YOUR STEP-BY-STEP GUIDE TO NDSU DINING CENTERS

1. Decide. You can eat at any dining center that best fits your needs. One way to choose is by location; which one are you closest to at meal times? You also can select based on the menu; each dining center serves something different. Check the NDSU Dining app and select a location based on your meal preference.

2. Choose dine-in or takeout: When you arrive at the dining center tell the cashier if you are enjoying your meal inside or to-go. Unlimited meal plan holders may take three meals to-go per day (one per meal period).



3. Access. Once you arrive at your dining center of choice, simply scan your finger, show your NDSU ID card or use your GET app.



4. Select. Browse around and make your selections. We are a tray-free facility, so simply grab a plate/dish at the station you select.

Utensils are placed in multiple places throughout the dining centers. Cups are near the beverages, and napkins are on each table.

5. Dish return: After you enjoy your meal bring your dishes/cups/utensils to the dish return area.

DIETARY NEEDS

WEST DINING CENTER AND CLEAN EATS

The West Dining Center is a peanut- and tree nut-free facility. Clean Eats is a food station located within the WDC that provides entrées, side items and desserts that are free from the top nine allergens, including gluten.

- Tree nuts (such as almonds, cashews, walnuts)

RESIDENCE DINING CENTER + UNION DINING CENTER

The Residence Dining Center and Union Dining Center also provide allergy-friendly options, customizable items and have a fridge stocked with gluten-free foods.

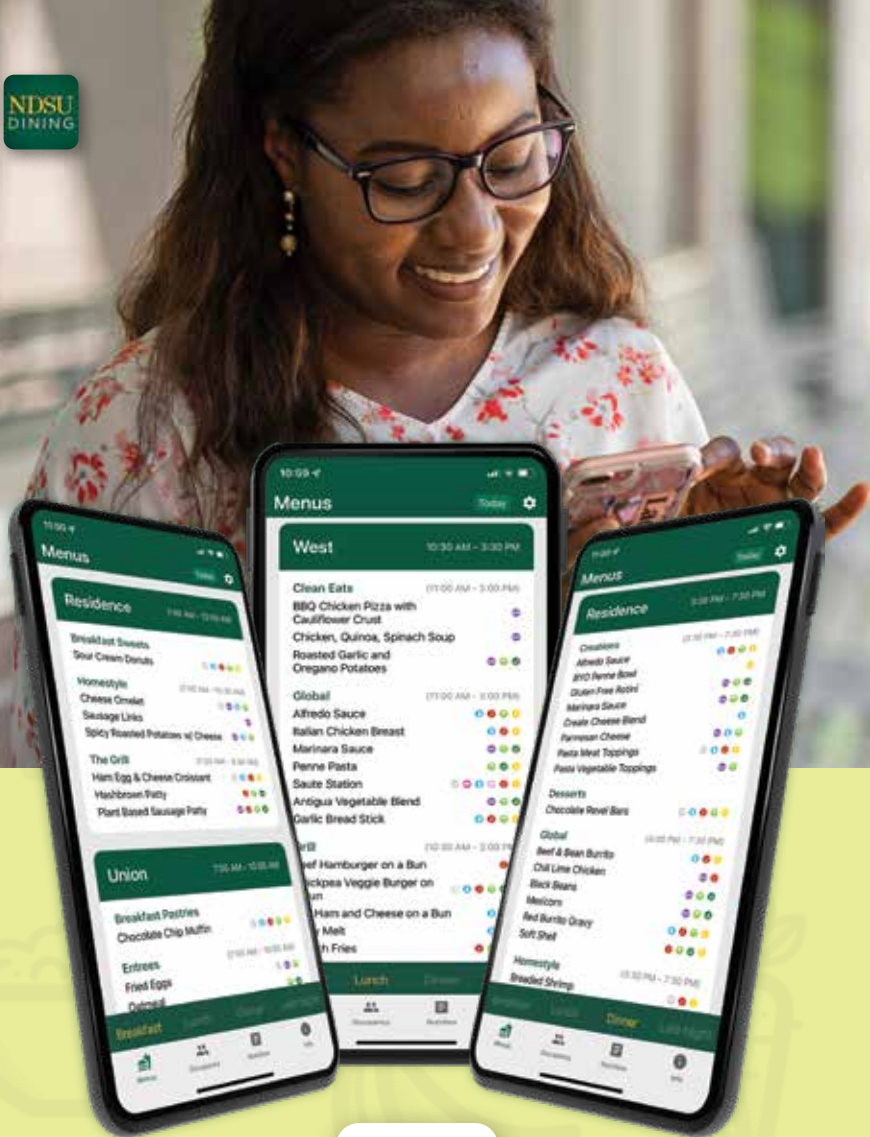
DIGITAL SIGNAGE

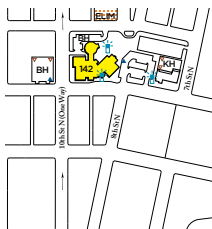
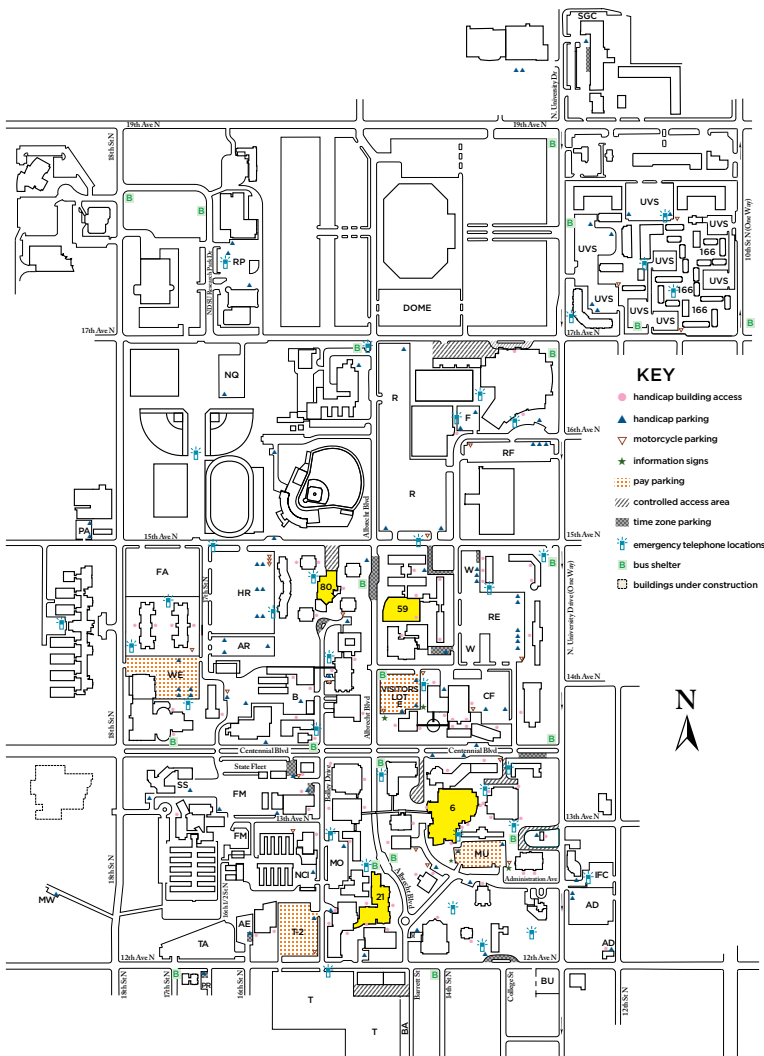
