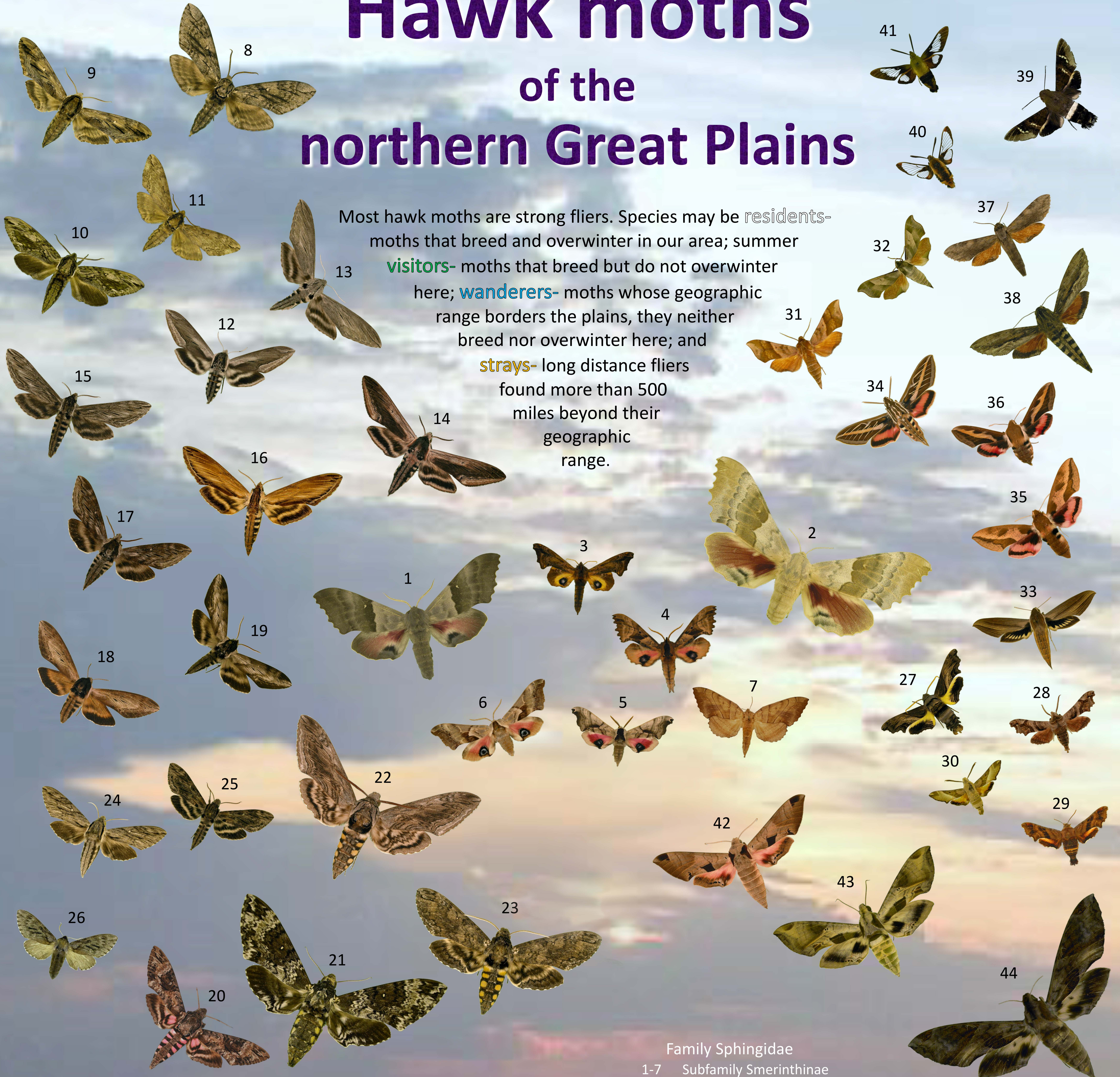


Hawk moths of the northern Great Plains

Most hawk moths are strong fliers. Species may be **residents**-moths that breed and overwinter in our area; **summer visitors**-moths that breed but do not overwinter here; **wanderers**-moths whose geographic range borders the plains, they neither breed nor overwinter here; and **strays**- long distance fliers found more than 500 miles beyond their geographic range.
