Nominations for Faculty Awards, 2017-2020

Overall, in the three academic years 2017-18, 2018-19, and 2019-20 the Faculty Awards and Recognition Committee has reviewed 170 nominations for 10 faculty awards (Tables 1 and 2). Awards provide a means to recognize and highlight faculty achievements while demonstrating NDSU's commitment to advancing faculty. Comparing number of nominations by award type, college, and gender may be helpful to units for improving their internal faculty evaluation and recognition processes.
