The US State Department requires sponsors to use an “objective measurement of English language proficiency” to determine a visitor’s command of the English language so that they can successfully participate in the assigned exchange program and function on a day-to-day basis. **Sponsors (NDSU) must also retain evidence of how they measured the applicant’s proficiency so that it may be made available to the Dept. of State upon request. (22 CFR 62.10(a)(2).)**
