
WHY IS ENGAGEMENT IMPORTANT?


- Academ ic engagem ent is associated with higheracadem ic achievem ent
- Variables im pacting studentengagem ent can be altered
- Som e of these variables, including teaching practices, are controlled by the teacher
- Teachers w ho use learner-centered practices elicithigher student engagem ent than teachers w ho use teacher-centered practices
- Collaboration am ong students and interactive leaming experiences support engagem ent
- Students are more likely to engage in classroom activities they perceive as meaningfuland interesting












- Begin with individual reflection

- Avoid putting students on the spot




- Focus on content


