# Democracy

- Every member has a right to participate in a respectful manner.
  - Those in the Minority are protected. (e.g. Limitation on member rights requires a 2/3 majority.)

2. Majority rules.


# Efficiency

- 1. Get 'er done approach.
  - 1. Germane.
  - 2. Avoid dilatoriness.
    - 1. Be prepared.
    - 2. Rules should not be abused.

#### \*SPECIAL RULES:

- Must be made by someone who voted on the winning side.
  - 2. Must be made same day or next day in a convention.
