Academic Honors available to HDFS/ Social Work Dual Degree Students

Honors available each semester

In any semester in which a student is taking at least 12 graded credits from NDSU, they are eligible for "Dean's List". As shown in the table below, if a student is following the standard 4-year plan, there are three semesters (sophomore fall, junior spring, and senior spring) in which they would not be taking enough NDSU credits to qualify for Dean's List. However, except for senior spring, they could, if desired, take 2 more NDSU credits in those semesters to bring them up to 12 to qualify. In senior spring, students take more than 12 credits from Minot State, and so are eligible for the Vice President for Academic Affairs Honor Roll or President's Honor Roll based on their grade in the graded credits they take that semester (i.e. SWK 491).

Graduation with Honors

At graduation, students can earn Honors at NDSU only, Minot State only, or both. Honors at NDSU is based on the student's cumulative GPA from NDSU credits only. Honors at Minot State is based on a student's overall cumulative GPA, including credits from NDSU and Minot.
