Darold Allan Bihrle, 87, a longtime resident of Wheaton, MN, passed away March 13, 2024, at Sanford Medical Center in Wheaton.

Darold was born July 9, 1936, in Sisseton, SD, to Harry and Amanda Bihrle, who moved to Wheaton shortly thereafter. He was baptized, and later confirmed in the Christian faith at Hope Lutheran Church in Wheaton.
