Students Bringing Dependent Family Members: Additional costs to be demonstrated if applicant plans to bring dependents: Spouse - \$9,000; Each child - \$4,000.

Living Expenses: This estimate reflects shared living accommodations with another student and the 7-day meal plan for one year. Required Health Insurance: All students are required to purchase the mandatory state health insurance policy, and this fee is charged at the beginning of each semester upon enrollment, except for citizens of Canada and Norway. Canadian and Norwegian residents may request an exemption to this requirement, but any exceptions to this are determined post-admission and post-issuance of an I-20 for F-1 students. See <https://www.ndsu.edu/international/iss/insurance>. J-1 students are required to have the mandatory policy regardless of country of origin.

Special account fees for international students NOT included in the above estimate: A one-time orientation fee of \$75 charged only in a student's first semester, which supports the Office of International Student and Study Abroad Services (and a \$200 New Student Fee for undergraduates only); and a separate \$85 international student support services fee applied each semester for all enrolled international students.
