Required Health Insurance: All students are required to purchase the mandatory state health insurance policy, and this fee is charged at the beginning of each semester upon enrollment, except for citizens of Canada and Norway. Canadian and Norway are required to purchase the mandatory state health insurance policy, and this fee is charged at the beginning of each semester upon enrollment, except for citizens of Canada and Norway. request an exemption to this requirement, but any exceptions to this are determined post-admission and post-issuance of an I-20 for F-1 students. Special account fees for international students NOT included in the above estimate: A one-time orientation fee of \$75 charged only in a student's first semester, which supports the Office of International Student and Study Abroad Services (and a \$200 New Student Fee for undergraduates only); and a separate \$85 international student support services fee applied each semester for all enrolled international students.
