

Currently the system is functioning as intended. The server was purchased in late April, and some simple testing was done to find a security solution as Duo was much too expensive. The utilized solution is called EvlWatcher and essentially scans the Event Logs for failed logins which then leads to a ban of that IP address being able to connect. The initial full rollout availability to students was on September 9, a couple weeks after intended due to delays in acquiring the Remote Desktop client licenses (resulting from failed communication from vendor to indicate availability). As of now the system is functioning as intended. ECE paid the extra \$432.50 needed to purchase the 50 Remote Desktop client licences required to complete this project.
