Students apply to the MLA Program at the conclusion of the first year. Transfer students may be accepted into the third year with approved transcripts. A grade of "C" or higher is required in all courses with an LA and ENVD prefix. If a student receives a grade of "D" or "F" in studio, student will be required to repeat the studio class the following year, before advancing to the next studio. One Professional Topics course may be replaced with a graduate course from another department, or

two with permission. Students may take up to 10 credit hours at the Graduate Level as

undergraduate students. Students apply to the Graduate School during the third year (90 credit hours): https://www.ndsu.edu/gradschool/apply. After three years of undergraduate study the student officially enters the MLA Graduate School and has two years of graduate study (3+2 program
