Kaplan Nursing Admissions Test

- **→** Students will complete the Kaplan Nursing Admission Test dates and times for each location is listed below in the important dates section
- → Applicants may consider purchasing the study guide: Kaplan Nursing School Entrance Exam (available through Amazon or other book retailers). This is not expected nor required.
- **→** \$50 for the exam plus \$29 proctoring fee = \$79

You will receive an email receipt of submission once the application is submitted.

Official communication from the School of Nursing will be sent via email Transcripts

- → Ensure transcripts from all schools attended (other than NDSU) were submitted to the Admissions office with your University application.
- **→** Transcripts do not need to be sent to the nursing department.

- → If you are taking courses in the spring semester at a school other than NDSU, you will need to have transcripts sent to the NDSU Registration and Records office as soon as grades are posted.
- + Students planning to apply to the Fargo site, you are <u>required</u> to contact your pre-nursing academic advisor via email to provide course(s) you are taking elsewhere
