## Why we do this?

Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973

Americans with Disabilities Act

NDSU Policy 100.1

### What is the Process to receive accommodations?

Student application online

Documentation from student's school, healthcare provider, psychiatrist, psychologist, or counselor

Student is paired with an accessibility specialist Interactive process with the student and specialist to determine barriers for access and major life activities that are affected by the disability

Accommodations are then approved by the specialist
