

What is IA?

- Digital materials accessed via a link in Bb course
- eBook and courseware options available
- Student participation rate remains high
 - Savings and convenience of Blackboard access

Blackboard Links

- eBooks and courseware from smaller publishers
 - NDSU Bookstore provides link instructions
- Courseware from larger publishers
 - Publisher representative provides link instructions





How Inclusive Access Works

Each Inclusive Access program is chosen and designed by your instructor, most include these eight milestones.

A professor adopts a title and a digital learning tool like My MathLab / Connect.







Digital course materials are integrated directly into Blackboard.







Students who are enrolled in an Inclusive Access course are automatically billed prior to the start of classes.



Students are notified they have until the opt-out deadline to opt-out of their course materials.



On the first day of class students click the course materials links in Blackboard to access their resources.









Students who drop a course before the opt-out deadline are automatically refunded.



The NDSU Bookstore deactivates accounts for students who chose to opt-out.



Students who opted-out are refunded for their course materials and are responsible for obtaining course materials independently.



Benefits

- First-day access for students
 - Improvements in student outcomes
 - Four studies done <u>www.CourseMaterialsResearch.com</u>
 - Students do not have to take additional steps to opt in
- Billed to student account (no credit card needed!)
- Low-cost print supplements available
- Quick implementation
- Avoid paper shortages and transit issues



Spring 2024

- > 24% of sections used IA items
 - 432 items for over 870 sections!
- > 79% of students used at least one IA item
- > 13% increase in items from Spring 2023
- Participation rate above 90%
- ➤ Student Savings = \$468,180+



Course Marking

- Low Cost Open Educational Resources (LOWCOST) This
 course uses free Open Educational Resources (OER) to eliminate
 conventional textbook costs but requires less than \$75 for required
 course materials
- No Cost Open Educational Resources (NOCOST) This course uses free Open Educational Resources (OER) or free textbook alternatives and does not require purchase of a textbook
- Low Cost Course Materials (LOWMAT) -This course uses a conventional textbook or software but requires less than \$75 in cost for required course materials
- No Course Materials Required (NOMAT)-This course does not require any course materials
