DUCATIONAL TRANSFORMATION AND WORKFORCE PROGRAMS: \$4.8M

Continue our momentum of transformative educational efforts that include curriculum review, student success initiatives, faculty and industry engagement, digital tool utilization and new workforce-aligned programs.

>> FUNDING FORMULA

NDSU supports the SBHE funding formula recommendations to:

- Remove the averaging function
- Address unintended consequences for growing institutions impacted by the credit completion factor
- Align credit weightings with highest demand degrees
- Formula enhancements, such as working in ND post-graduation, for legislative consideration



>> CHALLENGE GRANT: \$20M

Continue to invest in public/private matching opportunities to build workforce and applied research to benefit North Dakota.

>> TRANSFORMING STUDENT-WORKFORCE FOR THE FUTURE: \$25M

Create a transformative, student-workforce for the future, including leaders in engineering, precision agriculture, pharmacy, and allied and life sciences, while building a strong K-12 pipeline.



NDSU and UND are each requesting funds to drive additional computational and data-driven research in areas such as AI, genomics and bioinformatics, machine learning, and food, energy and water security.
