11. Disclosure: "NDSU has an obligation to make information available to the campus on where to get information about Registered Sex Offenders who are working on NDSU property. I also certify that I have health insurance coverage (or am covered under Medicare or Medicaid), and that my status will be as an independent contractor and not as an employee, and that I acknowledge that I am not entitled to any employment compensation, including pay, Workers Compensation coverage or any other benefits.

Each party shall be responsible for claims, losses, damages, and expenses proximately caused by its negligent or wrongful acts or omissions or those of its employees acting within the scope of their employment. The tort liability of the UNIVERSITY shall be determined pursuant to chapter 32-12.2 of the North Dakota Century Code and is subject to the conditions and limitations contained therein.

19. Termination:

This Agreement may be terminated at any time upon the written mutual consent of the parties. Either party may terminate or suspend performance of this Agreement for failure of the other party to perform any of the services, duties or conditions contained in this Agreement after giving the other party written notice of the stated failure. The written notice must demand performance of the stated failure within a specified period of time of not less than 30 days if any license, permit or certificate required by law or rule, or by the terms of this contract, is for any reason denied, revoked, suspended or not renewed.
