### NIH Org Chart

- <u>List</u> and description of the 27 NIH Institutes and Centers (I/Cs)
- Center for Scientific Review (CSR) is independent of the I/Cs - responsible for most of the receipt, referral, peer-review
- NIH Common Fund
  - Common Fund Cross Cutting Programs

#### Funding Announcements

Three types of generic announcement types:

- Parent Announcement (investigator initiated)
- Standard Schedule
- Program Announcements (PA, PAR, PAS)
  - Reviewed by standing review panels
  - Institute/Center POs have discretion on payline cuts



#### **Funding Announcements**

- Notice of Special Interest (NOSI)
- Request for Applications (RFA)
  - Very specific request, special review panels
  - Use set-aside funds
- Request for Proposals (RFPs, contracts)
- Grant Basics (for those New to NIH)
- Funding Announcement Tool

#### NIH R15

- Stimulate NIH research at institutions that are not major recipients of NIH funding
- Strengthen recipient institution's capacity to compete for future NIH \$
- Expose undergrad/grads to biomedical research
- Research Plan
  - 1-page Specific Aims
  - 12 –page research strategy
  - \$300K over 3 years
  - Renewable
