2. Applications are due on September 20 at 5pm to the Student Activities Office.
3. Homecoming Court Interviews are Wednesday, September 22 from 4pm-10pm. Photos will be taken before the interview.
4. Homecoming Court will be released on Friday, September 24 at 9am.

Homecoming Voting is October 5 at 8am-October 6 at 5pm

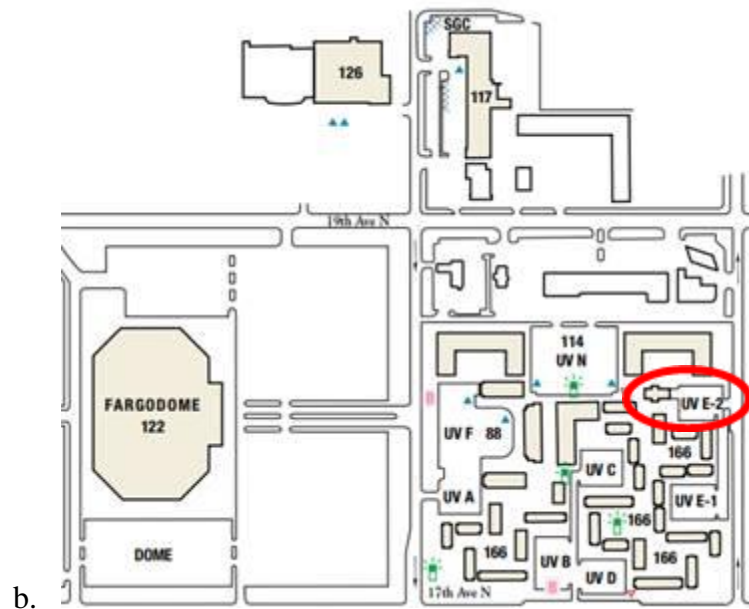
