Action Items:

2017-2018 Events:

- **November 20, 2017 – Salvation Army Red Kettle Bell Ringing from 10am-2pm:** Recruited volunteers to ring the bell for a holiday fund raising drive. Shifts of 1 hour with 2 people each where offered, and filled quickly (however, some people missed their shift, but we had at least one person per hour for the 4 hours). The ringing station was held within the south doors of the Memorial Union, close to the NDSU Bookstore.
- **December 6, 2017 – Salvation Army Red Kettle Bell Ringing from 10am-2pm:** Recruited volunteers to ring the bell for a holiday fund raising drive. Shifts of 1 hour with 2 people each where offered, and filled quickly (however, some people missed their shift, but we had at least one person per hour for the 4 hours). The ringing station was held within the south doors of the Memorial Union, close to the NDSU Bookstore.
- **December 12, 2017 – United Blood Services Blood Drive from 1-3:45pm:** We had 18 slots, with 17 appts. – the goal was 13. This drive was located on the west side of the Memorial Union.
- **March 1, 2018 – United Blood Services Blood Drive from 1-3:45pm:** We had 17 slots, with 15 appts. – the goal was 11. This drive was located on the west side of the Memorial Union.
- **June 12, 2018 – United Blood Services Blood Drive from 8:15-11am:** We had 18 slots, with 15 appts. – the goal was 13. This drive was located in front of Ceres Hall.
