#### TIPS FOR RESEARCH & WRITING PAPERS:

- Make a plan: Writing is a process with many steps. Start early, make a plan, and break down each step.
- **Understand your assignment**: What is the purpose of the assignment? Who is your audience? What resources do you need? Ask your instructor if you have questions, and/or visit the Center for Writers.
- **Remember**: Writing in college is different than writing in high school. Your task as a scholar is to present an informed argument to your readers.

# **UC Berkley's Considerations for Evaluating Sources:**

- 1. Authority Who is the author? What is their point of view?
- 2. **Purpose** Why was the source created? Who is the intended audience?
- 3. **Publication & format** Where was it published? In what medium?
- 4. **Relevance** How is it relevant to your research? What is its scope?
- 5. **Date of publication** When was it written? Has it been updated?
- 6. **Documentation** Did they cite their sources? Who did they cite?
