



Equipment storage building

Approximately \$633,500 in potato research equipment has no dedicated storage building. Equipment is difficult to obtain, and this would prolong the life of equipment for research. A $60 \times 120 \text{ ft}^2$ building is requested.



Forklift

Potatoes are heavy and moving potatoes is difficult, dangerous, and takes much labor as this is done by hand. A forklift would improve efficiencies, safety, and reduce hard drops and bruising.



Potato grader

Grading potatoes is essential to providing quality research growers can rely on to make decisions. Current grading capabilities are limited to one outdated grader at NDSU. Approximate cost for a new grader is \$300,000.



Storage boxes

Storing potatoes in bags, placed in plastic tote boxes would improve efficiencies in storage. Stacking boxes would allow storage of more research projects.
